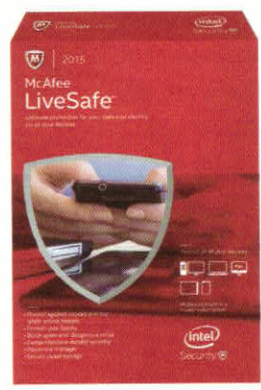

HTC Tackles Smartphone-ography With RE: HTC's latest product isn't a smartphone or tablet – it's the company's first portable video camera. The **RE** (pronounced "ree") has a capacitive sensor that recognizes when it's picked up and gets the camera ready for the action, and a wide 140-degree fixed lens for capturing the full scene. Need a viewfinder? Connect an iOS or Android device via Bluetooth. The fully waterproof camera shoots stills at 16MP, and video at 1,080p, with slow motion (at 80 fps) and time-lapse options. The battery lasts for up to 90 minutes of continuous video recording, or can sit on standby for up to two months. Save recorded content to microSD card, transfer it via Wi-Fi Direct, or set the device to automatically
